Statement of the Executive Committee on Behalf of the Samuel J. Tilden Democratic Club

To the members of the Samuel J. Tilden Democratic Club, it has become clear that Mayor Adams has lost the confidence and trust of his staff, his colleagues in government, and New Yorkers.

New York City and New Yorkers deserve a stable government that reflects the moral values and principles that we expect of our leaders. We expect our leadership to put our communities and the lives of our families before their personal dilemmas, and we elect them to steer the population forward. The Mayor has put that at risk.
